MBRB COVID-19 Policy

MBRB places safety above all others in the matrix of decision-making. The safety of our hunters and the general public is the critical factor in delaying, postponing or cancelling a controlled hunt.

Our landowners have stated they plan to conduct hunts this fall, as close to “normal” as is possible. Although there are many unknowns at this time (May 2020), the MBRB Board intends to support our landowners in this effort.

However, as there are yet many possible impacts from the management of the COVID-19 situation, we also want all of our hunters to be advised that things may change at any time up to the start of the hunts, including cancellations. If that should occur, MBRB hunters will be refunded their enrollment fee for the season.

The Board will be working with our landowners to determine and devise appropriate measures for safely conducting the hunts, which may include “virtual” orientation meetings and/or other technology aids to reduce human-to-human contact.

This policy will be modified several times over the course of the summer of 2020, so do check back frequently for updated versions.
