## **MBRB Crossbow Policy**

The use of a crossbow in any and all MBRB special hunts is limited to those who are 60 years of age and older or for those who have a medically documented physical disability which precludes them from using traditional archery equipment or a compound bow. Hunters must also hunt from an elevated stand.

Hunters who are within the above outlined guidelines and have been drawn as a primary or alternate for a hunt, who will be using a crossbow please know that; **you are required to bring proof of either (1). Age** *or* 

## (2). A medically documented disability, to Orientation.

Failure to provide the required information at Orientation will result in your dismissal from the hunt you were drawn for. This documentation <u>must</u> be presented the night of Orientation to your hunt Coordinator; no exception.
