## **Underage Hunter Policy**

A hunter who is 17 must have a parent or legal guardian sign a waiver of liability. A parent must understand that the MBRB is NOT a mentorship program, nor a hunter education organization. To participate in an MBRB hunt, hunters are expected to be experienced effective, proficient, ethical bowhunters. The MBRB acknowledges that some underage hunters have worked hard for several years with a mentor to meet these expectations. However, the minimum age to participate as a hunter in the MBRB is 17 years old.

Underage hunters must meet all MBRB requirements to participate:

- Visit <a href="https://mbrb.org/app/">https://mbrb.org/app/</a> select box "I am new to MBRB: Register a New Account" when annual hunter registration begins (typically beginning in early summer).
- Provide MN Bowhunter Education Certificate Course Info
- Take and pass an <u>annual MBRB Proficiency shooting test</u> at a participating metro area <u>Archery shop1</u>
- Sign an ethics pledge
- Waiver (as described above) must be signed
- Pay application/administration fee

After successfully completing all registration requirements a new hunter will receive an MBRB hunter ID number and may apply to participate in an MBRB hunt(s). If randomly selected by the automated electronic system for a hunt, **the underage hunter must be independent.** This includes tasks such as climbing, hanging tree stands, tracking deer, field dressing deer, and removing deer from the field. All transportation to and from 1.) a mandatory orientation meeting and 2.) the hunt location on all the days of the hunt, must be arranged by the underage hunter/parent/guardian. The MBRB cannot provide transportation.
